The fellowship is designed for healthcare professionals outside the U.S. who possess an MD and are interested in gaining further exposure in Emergency Ultrasound. The International Fellowship in Emergency Ultrasound at Mass General Brigham can be fully in person in Boston, fully virtual, or combination of virtual and in person.



Program Description

The International Fellowship in Emergency Ultrasound is a fellowship-level training that will introduce individuals to all facets of Point-of-Care Ultrasound (POCUS). The training program has four primary components: education, leadership, research, and innovation. You will learn how to both acquire and interpret both basic and advanced POCUS applications. In addition, you will have the opportunity to observe an attending physician in the emergency department to practice ultrasound acquisition skills.

Core Curriculum

- Didactics: a range of topics including cardiac, thoracic, e-fast, MSK, aorta ultrasound, and Ultrasound Hands on Training Workshops
- Ultrasound administration
- Ultrasound quality assurance
- Ultrasound research
- Image acquisition, interpretation and feedback
- Presentation creation, feedback, and delivery
